Radius International	 Gap Year Intern Commitment: mid Aug to Mid June each year. Radius Interns play a vital role in the mission of RI while simultaneously gaining valuable ministry experience and opportunities to grow in their faith. This is done by serving the staff and students of RI, attending classes, one-on-one discipleship, and participating in cultural and language learning activities. The internship is a great opportunity for young people that want to SERVE, LEARN, and GROW. SERVE -The primary role of Interns is to serve. This service may look slightly different from intern to intern but is primarily done in the following areas: Childcare -The primary area that female Interns serve is in caring for students' children in the mornings during class from 7:50am-12:10pm. Hospitality - Additional responsibilities include helping with the kitchen (heating up and/or putting away student meals), regular cleaning of guest rooms, and other needs that arise. Maintenance - Male interns will be driving some of our guests and adjunct professors between campuses and sometimes do airport runs as well as some manual labor as we maintain our campuses or have other projects. LEARN - A valuable component to the Gap Year program is the Interns ability to grow intentionally through a program that consists of: Bible classes, Spanish lessons, Guided book readings, Living in a foreign country - All interns live at one of the two RI campuses in Mexico and a large portion of their time is spent out in the community learning the culture and interacting with locals. GROW - For all of the serving and learning that takes place during the year here, it is essential that Interns grow in their faith while serving. RI places a high priority on the individual growth of Interns and each person participates in the following: One-on-one discipleship, Small groups, Spiritual disciplines, Living in community. 	 All internships begin in mid-August and end mid-June with a month-long Christmas break. The cost is \$4500 for the year, which can be paid in a lump sum or broken into monthly payments.
