What scholarships or grants are usually applicable to study abroad trips?

Visit the Office of Financial Aid to find out what scholarships and grants are applicable towards studying abroad. You can also find many of these scholarships through <u>ScholarshipUniverse</u>, available to all admitted students at BJU.

What does "all-inclusive" really include?

Our study abroad courses are "all-inclusive," meaning the listed price covers the cost of airfare, lodging and utilities, meals, transportation, and admission to museums and attractions unless otherwise specified in the course information. Extra expenses like passport/visa fees and souvenirs are not covered in the course price.

Can anyone not enrolled at Bob Jones University apply to go on a study abroad trip?

Bob Jones University does not currently allow those outside of the student body to participate in a study abroad program. However, for anyone not enrolled at BJU that would like to sign up for a study abroad course, expedited enrollment is available.

Do any special rules or policies apply to international students?

International students are eligible and encouraged to enroll in study abroad courses! Students should check for any rules about obtaining a visa based on their home country and target country.

If I decide not to go on a study abroad trip but have already made payments, can I get a refund?

No refunds are given unless the course is cancelled by the University.
